Last Week

Last week, our class explored the theme "Face Your Face" through reflective narrative essays about personal growth. Students began with a guided meditation to recall childhood memories and reflect on their changes that make up their identity in the present. They practiced reading skills by identifying key story information and elements, and answering reflective questions with textual evidence. To organize their ideas, they used graphic organizers like bubble maps and T-

charts, then drafted their essays in first-person perspective. Speaking activities, such as sharing sessions, presentations, and storytelling, helped strengthen their oral communication skills.

This Week

This week, students will continue refining and finalizing their reflective narrative essays, focusing on clarity, structure, personal voice, and conventions. In reading, they will analyze how different story elements interact and contribute to the overall narrative. The week will conclude with student presentations to share their personal stories, and a reflective question and answer session.

The learning skill and curriculum expectations being focused on this week include:

Learning Skill: Organization, self-regulation, and Independent Work

Speaking: Students engaged in presentations, storytelling, and question and answer sessions.

Reading: Students read and identify key story information and elements, and answer reflective questions with textual evidence in a reflective narrative essay. They also analyzed a reflective narrative essay to understand how different story elements interact and contribute to the narrative as a whole. They used graphic organizers to identify and organize key information.

Writing: Students wrote a reflective narrative essay and responses to reading material. Students also applied capitalization and punctuation rules, correct spelling, subject-verb agreement, pronouns, and adverbial phrases on their reflective narrative essay.

這週,學生將針對清晰度、結構、個人聲音和語言規範,繼續修正並完成他們的反思敘事文章。 在閱讀部分,他們將分析不同的故事元素如何互 動並對整體敘事產生貢獻。本週將以學生分享他 們的個人故事,並進行反思問答方式作為結尾。

本週學習技能與課程目標:

學習技巧:組織能力、自我調適、獨立作業

口說:學生們參與了演講、講故事和問答環節。

閱讀:學生們閱讀並指出故事中的關鍵資訊和元素,並在反思敘事文章中運用文本證據回答反思問題。他們還分析了一篇反思敘事文章,了解不同的故事元素如何互動並對故事整體產生變化。 他們運用組織圖來指出和整理關鍵資訊。

寫作:學生們撰寫了反思敘事文章並回答閱讀資源的相關問題。他們也在反思敘事文章中應用了 大寫和標點符號規則、正確的拼寫、主詞語動詞 一致、代名詞和副詞短語。
